A. Oral Test

I. Questions and answers. (20%)

- 1. How does Bert feel when he hurts his finger while fixing his bicycle? \rightarrow He is angry when he hurts his finger while fixing his bicycle.
- 2. Is Bert sad when he doesn't have oatmeal for breakfast?
 → Yes, he is. He's sad when he doesn't have oatmeal for breakfast.
- 3. When does Bert feel scared?
 → He feels scared when he sees a ghost on TV.
- 4. How does Bert feel when he is with his friend? \rightarrow <u>He feels happy.</u>
- 5. Do you feel happy now? (answer may vary)
